Ikenobo Arrangement Set* \$80+

*This set is optional but recommended for beginners. It is available from the instructor on the first day of class. The container, shears, and kenzan can be bought separately for approximately \$30.

Set includes (all pictured above):

- ❖ 1- Shallow flower container (10" width, 3" depth, 4" height)
- 1- Table cover
- 1 #8 Kenzan
- 1 Ikebana floral shears
- 1 Floral shears blade cover

Important Notes



Students are not required to purchase the items from the instructor but it is recommended. If bringing your own materials, please get as close to the required dimensions as possible. Vases may be bought for \$65-\$75 each from the instructor. For questions, please call 561-233-1367.

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

TALL VASE (1) & SHALLOW VASE (1)



Ideally, conical or flare shape approximately 10" high with an opening at least 3.5" wide. Pictured example: 9.5" height, 6"- wide opening



Approximately 3" deep and at least 8" across. Pictured example: 12" length, 6.5" width, 2" depth

#8 KENZAN (2)



Also known as a pin frog. If bringing your own, please make sure the pin is 3" wide and that needles are at least ½" tall

AQUARIUM GRAVEL



Please bring enough to fill the tall vase if you are using that style. Gravel may be found at your local pet stores for fish tanks.

*Gravel is not available from the instructor.

Floral shears/Pruners



Please bring shears specifically for flowers and not typical garden shears.
