## Cosplay Rules

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**We reserve the right not to allow anyone to enter that does not follow the following rules:**

- **This is a family show so keep it rated PG. There will be children in attendance. If you could not wear the costume in front of your grandmother, you shouldn't wear it here.**
  - **No nudity. No costume is no costume.**
  - **No profanity allowed. That includes messages on signs or clothes.**
  - **No political or religious statement during the film.**
- **Do not use any sort of projectile at all! Nothing must leave your person while you are attending the film or the Morikami for that matter. No flashpots, explosive devices, or similar special effects are to be used.**
- **No Weapons allowed!**
  - **Any prop that is perceived as a weapon will not be allowed. If security deems a prop or part of your costume as a hazard you will be asked to leave and store the piece in your car.**
- **Morikami will not be responsible for your items, leave them at your own risk. Bring them to your vehicles if at all possible.**
- **Large elaborate costumes will not be allowed to enter the theater.**
- **To maintain a memorable experience for all, we ask that all hair and make-up, and wardrobe changes, if applicable, be completed before entering the museum and gardens. There are public restrooms available for changing at Lake Biwa pavilion.**
- **MOST IMPORTANT:**
  - **Costumes must be self contained. You **MUST** be able to sit in a theater seat with out impeding on the area around you and the vision of those behind you.**
  - **Anyone who violates any of the above rules may be asked to leave.**
